## **Sexually Violent Predator Community Notification Bulletin**

The Johnstown Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes 16-13-901 through 16-13-905, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when the offender has been determined to be a <u>SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATOR</u> and is subject to community notification. The purpose of this notification is to enhance public safety and protection.

ROGERIO MARTINEZ has been classified as a <u>Sexually Violent Predator</u> and as such is considered to pose a greater than normal risk to the community.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

As of November 3, 2023 Colorado has **19,212** registered sex offenders living in the state. There are **30** sex offenders registered with the Johnstown Police Department. There are **445** offenders living in Colorado that have been evaluated and meet the criteria to be designated as a Sexually Violent Predator, **1** of whom lives in Johnstown.
